The scientific committee reserves the right to decide if the abstract will be presented as a lecture or a poster.

Oral and poster presentations

There is a time limit for oral presentations of 15 minutes and 5 minutes for discussion. Oral presentations will be held in parallel sessions.

Generally 45 minutes will be allowed for plenary lectures.

Beamer projection (Power Point) and overhead projection are provided. Disk or USB stick are accepted.

Poster size is A1 (width 595mm x height 841mm). Posters have to be presented from Monday afternoon to Wednesday afternoon.

Excursion A

Treibacher Chemische Werke, Althofen

Treibacher Industry AG is a chemical company in Althofen-Treibach, Carinthia. The company was established in 1898 by Carl Auer von Welsbach, the so-called "Treibacher Chemische Werke".

Known under the trade name "Auermetall", they produce flintstones for pocket lighter. They also produce functional ceramic, ceramic coatings, components and assemblies, rare earths and products for steel industry and foundry.

Auer von Welsbach Museum:

The Auer von Welsbach-Museum offers a unique display of unique exhibits of the first metal filament lamp, an impressive collection of the rarest lighters and the earliest gas mantle light. Apart from the first colour photographs in Austria, made by Carl Auer von Welsbach in 1908, the visitor will find the laboratory which is furnished with the original equipment and tools used by the most distinguished Austrian discoverer and inventor.

Manuscripts of famous scientists and innumerable other rarities augment this fascinating exhibit that is a pleasure for the lay and expert person alike.

Excursion B

Donau Chemie Werke, Brückl

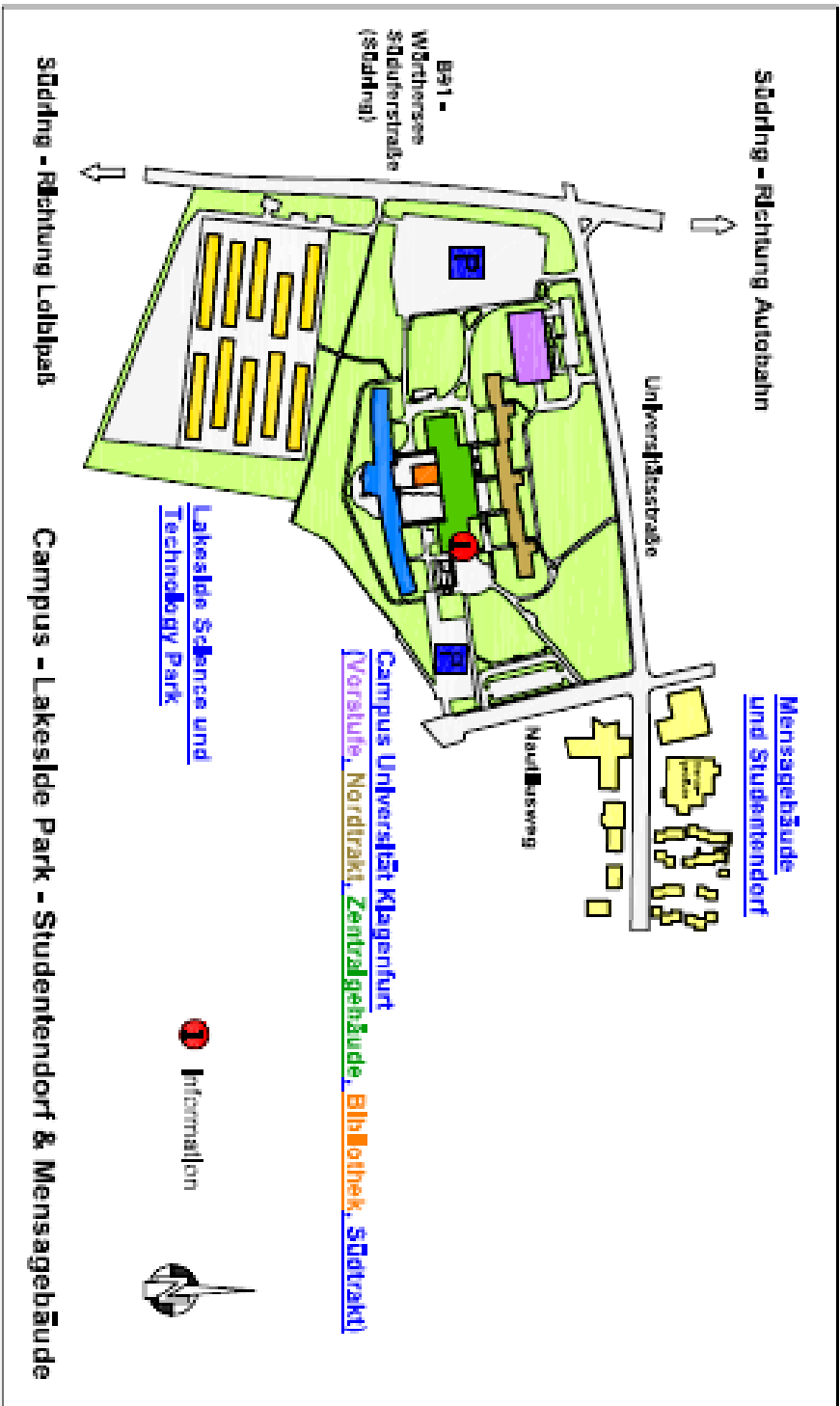
